He wanted a building where the natural structure of the landscape was an integral part of the design. In some cases he even left the untouched granite mountain as part of the building. Light and a sense of volume were important to him thus the large windows everywhere with view of Lake Mälaren

Lastberget is designed for Meetings of all sizes. With its 81.000 sq feet on three levels but under one roof, Lastberget provides a dining room, sitting room, group rooms, several modern conference rooms , gym, relax area, single and double rooms and much, much more. All built and maintained with the idea that Lastberget can tailor make a conference that provides the greatest return on invested time and money.

After a day of meetings and intensive communication few things are more relaxing than a walk in the woods. Lastberget has a 1.7 km lighted trail through the woods. Or one can take a short five minute walk down to the lake to get a breath of fresh air and be inspired by the call of a loon.
