The grounds surrounding Lastberget provide endless possibilities for getting together. For example our jetty on Lake Mälaren is only a five minute walk to the lake and gives you a chance to dangle your feet in the water or roast a hotdog over an openfire. Or take a " walk-and-talk" on one of trails in the woods then stop and admire the view from the chosen lookout points. This can be a truly a creative and relaxing moment.

You can stop and see where and why Lastberget got its name. In the mid - 1800s, timmer on the property would be cut during the Winter. It would be pulled through the snow with horses to a high point at the waters edge When Spring came and melted the ice the timber could simply be pushed off the ledge into the lake for easy transport and sale in Stockholm. Thus the name Lastberget.
